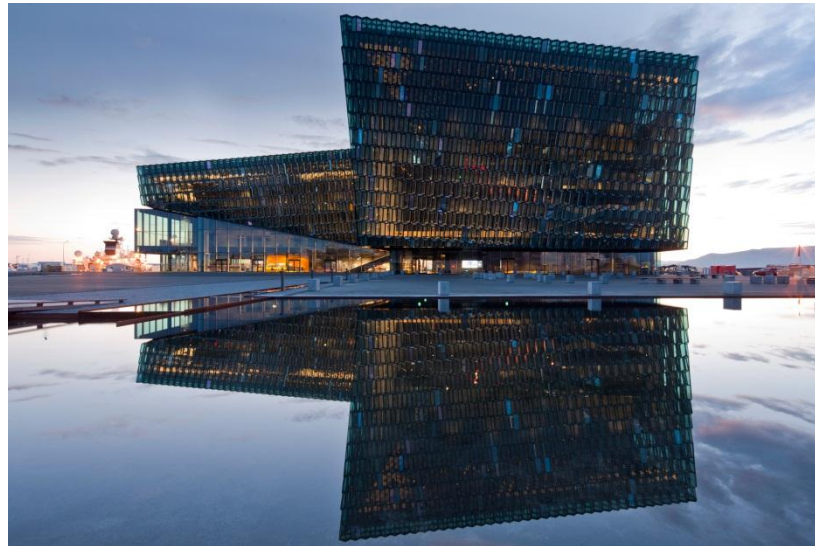

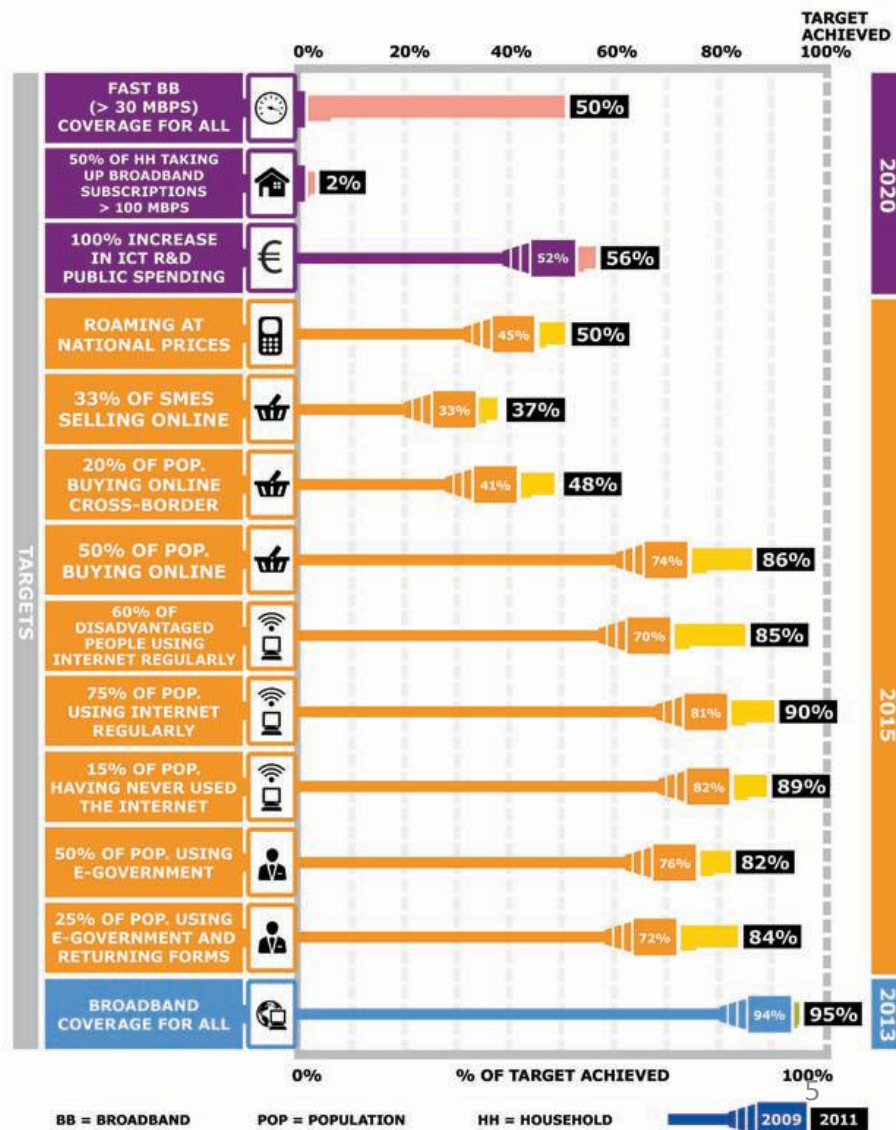

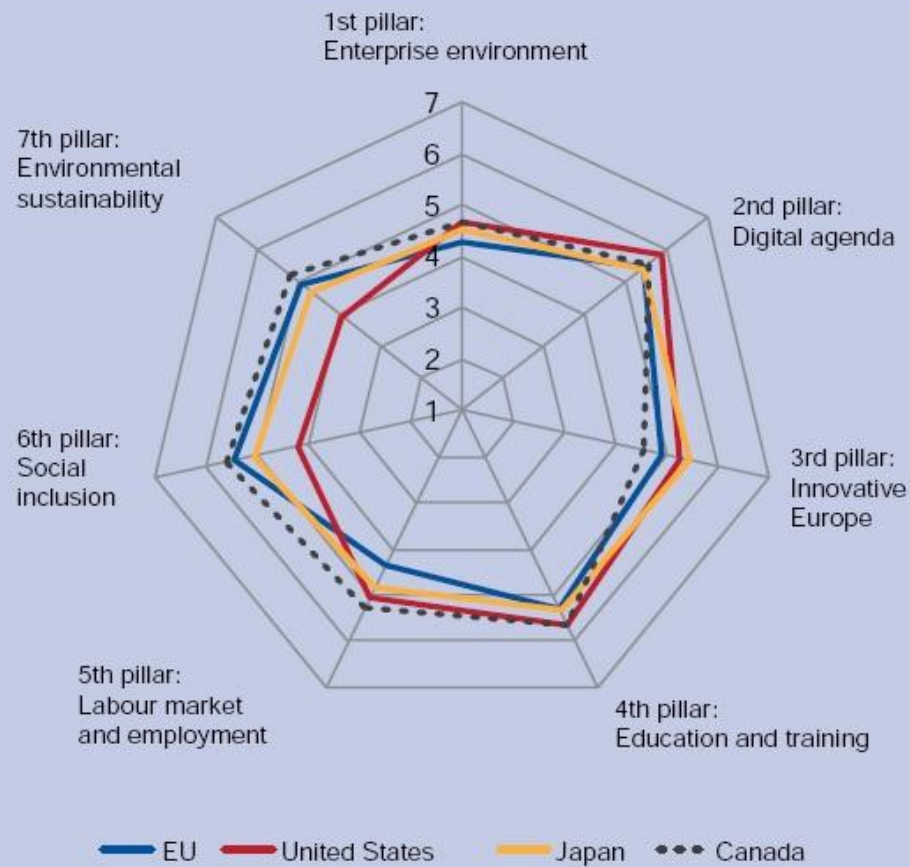

# DAE – progress since 2010

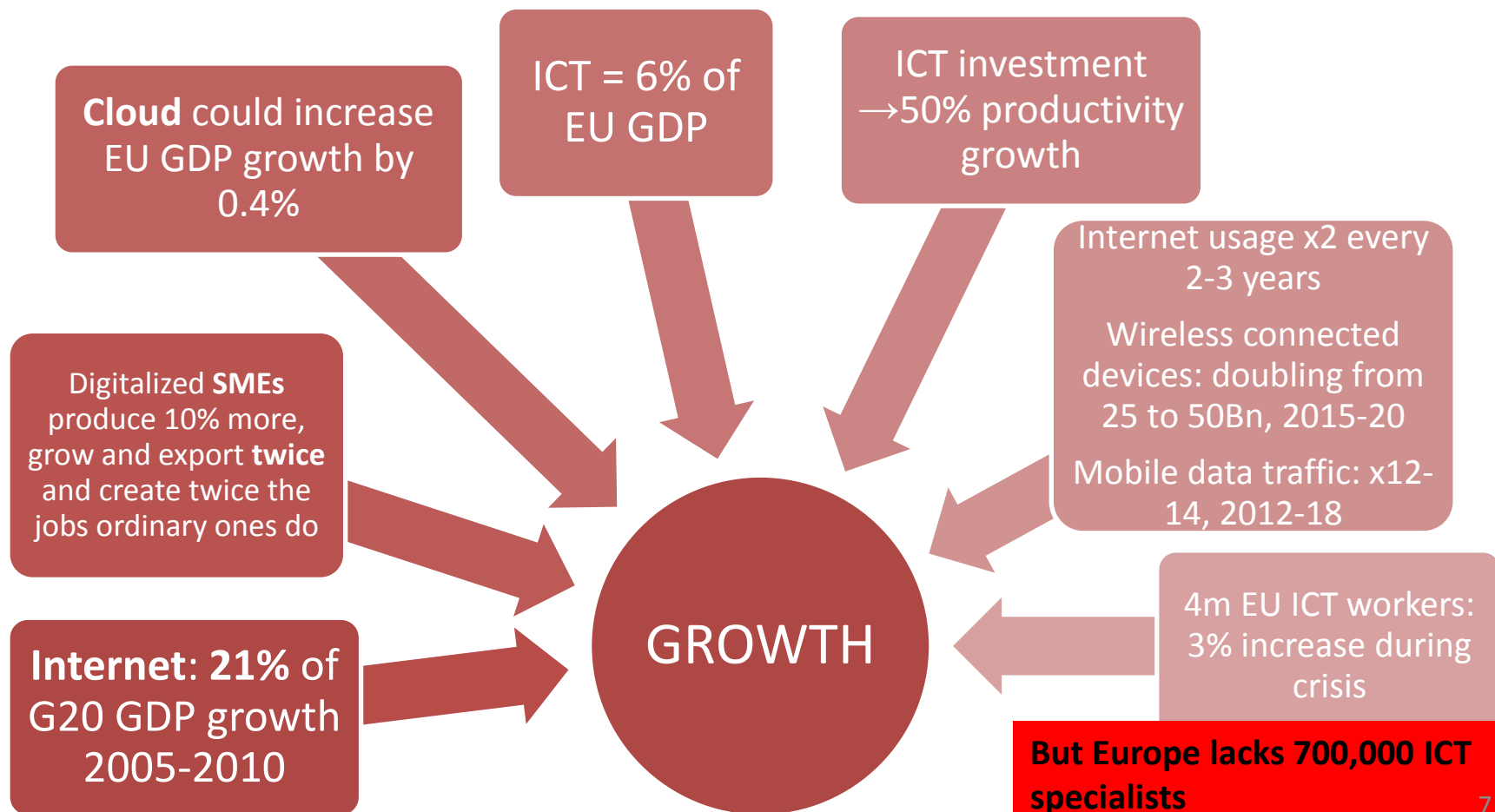
- Delivered:

5% expected increase of European GDP by 2020

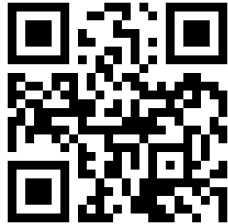
